FUNDING LANDSCAPE

Discretionary Grants

- Most often awarded through a competitive application process
- Review by a managing federal agency

Formula Grants

- Awarded to state agencies or regional MPO based on a formula
- Distributed to projects by regional entities, potentially through a competitive application process

Other Mechanisms

- Rebates
- Tax credits and deductions
- Etc.

Be ready!

- 1 Data gathering, alternatives analysis, identify purpose and need.
- 2 Work with the applicable agencies to get your project into your TIP or STIP.
- 3. Sign up for newsletters from potential granting agencies (FTA, FHWA, MARAD, USDOT, EPA, and DOE) to get notifications of when grants are released.
- Review agency resources to identify other opportunities that might be applicable for your project.
- Begin compiling key grant inputs/ project scope items (i.e. potential cost, potential emissions savings calculations)
