
## **About Us**

- AML is a part of the Lynden Family of Companies that provides transportation and logistics solutions around the world.




# **Our History**



- 1906 Lynden Transfer was established in Lynden, WA with two horses and an iron wheeled wagon
- 1954 Lynden makes its first trip over the Alcan from Seattle to Alaska
- 1980 Southeast Alaska Barge Service begins



# **Connecting Southeast Alaska**



- We move all types of freight from the lower 48 to Southeast Alaska – from necessities like groceries and cars to oversized cranes and other bulky materials for diverse projects in the mining, and construction industries.
- Additionally, we transport export goods from Alaska to the lower 48, connecting our seafood and other industries to the rest of the world.
- Intra-Alaska barge transportation connects SE Communities to each other



## **Service Into Southeast Alaska**



- We proudly offer twice weekly scheduled service from Seattle to Southeast Alaska year round
- We have never missed a sailing, even with delays due to weather and tides
- We kept Alaska moving during the Pandemic, providing essential goods to the region



## **Southeast Areas Serviced**

#### AML Mainline Barge:

- Twice weekly: Ketchikan, Petersburg, and Juneau
- Once weekly: Haines, Skagway and two remote mines
- Once monthly: Yakutat

#### Shuttle barge via Petersburg:

- Twice weekly: Sitka
- Once weekly: Kake
- Summer service: Hoonah, Tenakee Springs, and Excursion Inlet

#### Shuttle barge via Ketchikan:

Once weekly: Prince of Wales and Wrangell
