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About NADO

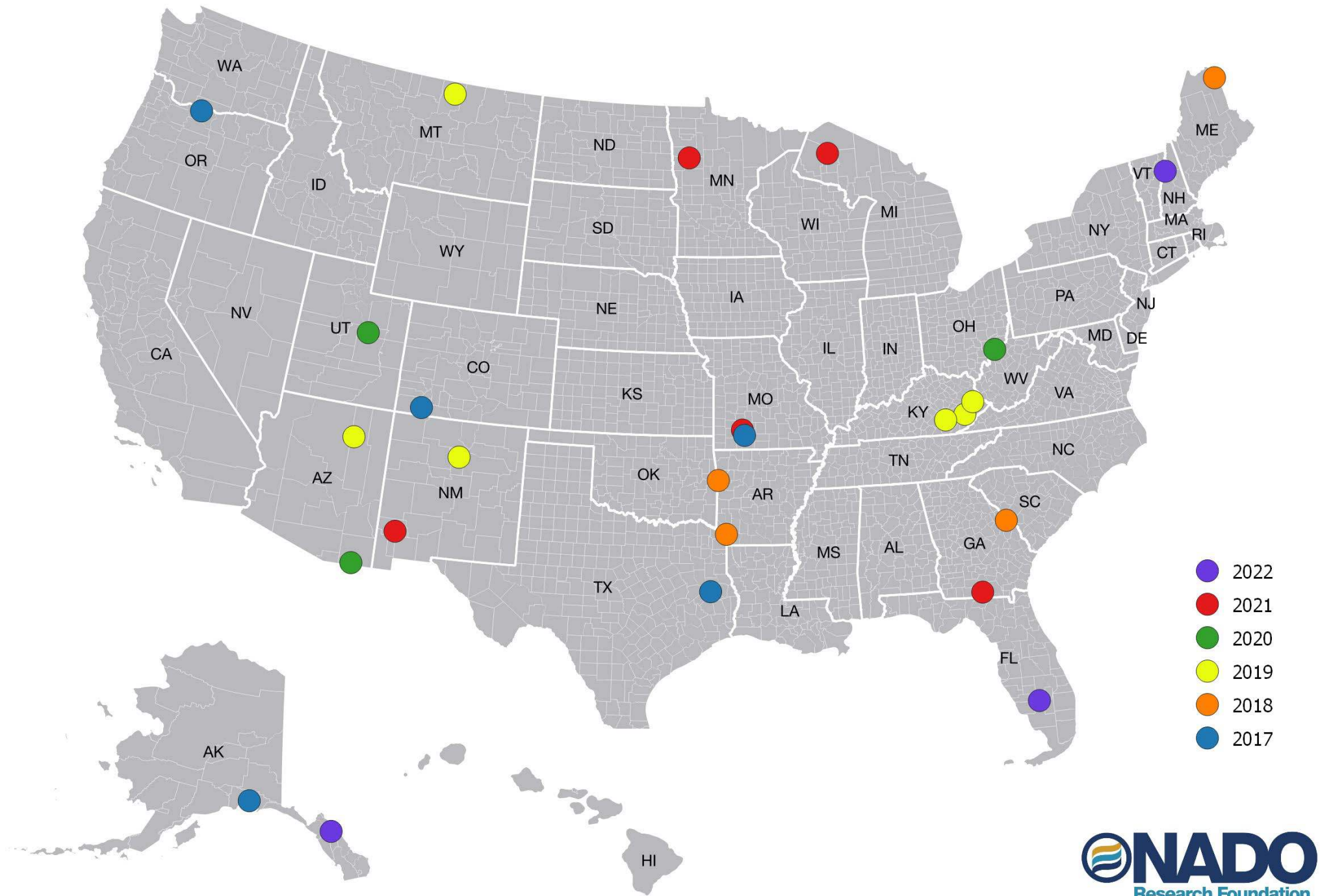
- National association for 540 regional development organizations, including emerging network of Rural Transportation Planning Organizations (RTPOs or RPOs);

 - Connect to implementation opportunities

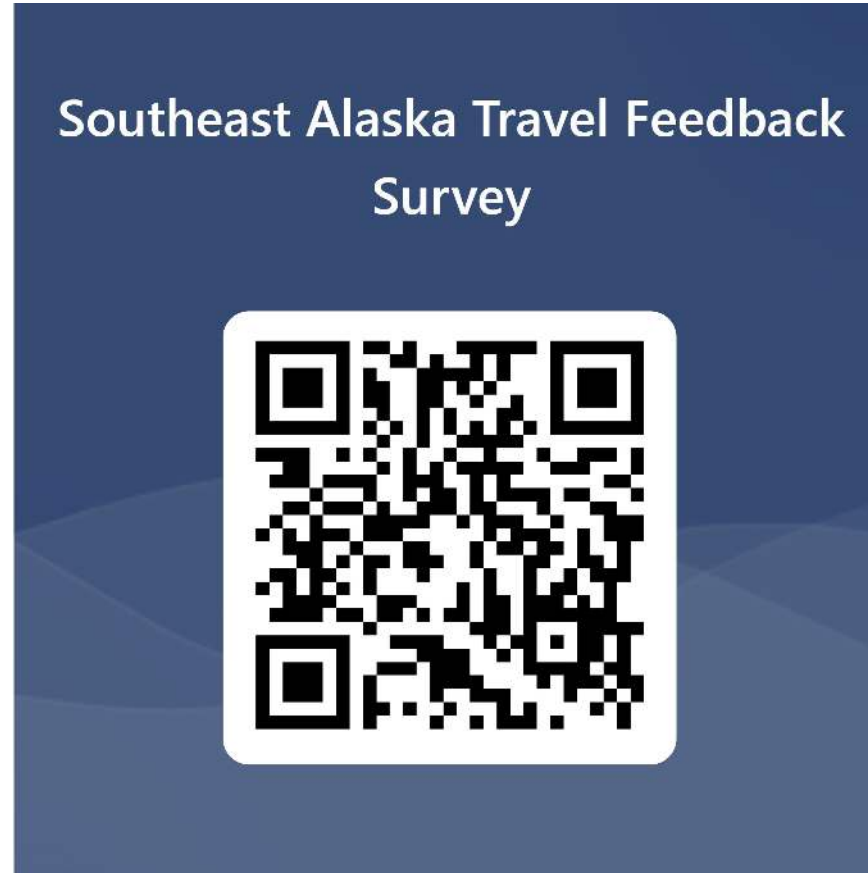


Southeast Alaska Technical Assistance
